

On 10th April in 1912 the Titanic set off from England to New York. The Titanic was made by the company Harland and Wolff in Belfast. It took 3 years to build.

The Titanic was about 9000 feet, the boat was sailing in the Atlantic when 4 days later the Titanic hit an iceberg. If in the boat were 2,000 passengers only were 705 survivors.

They were until 1998 pieces for part of the bottom of the wreck.



The Titanic

The Titanic was a very big ship, it was 900 feet long and it weighed 50,000 tonnes. On 10th April 1912, the Titanic set off from England to New York. Four days later hit an iceberg. Water began to pour into the ship. Later the Titanic broke into two pieces. There were 20 lifeboats. They were 2,200 passengers but only 705 survivors.

On 10th April 1912 the Titanic set off from England on its first voyage to New York. The famous ship was almost 2,900 long and 28 feet tall and 50,000 tonnes. Four days later, at 11:40 pm the ship crashed into an iceberg. Two hours and forty minutes later, the Titanic broke into two pieces and went down to the bottom of the ocean.

They survived 705 passengers, and over 2,200 weren't so lucky. For many years nobody managed to find the ship. Finally, in 1985, a research team found the wreck but it took to be recovered from the water. You can see one museum in the USA have exhibitions of some of the 5,000 different objects from the ship.
